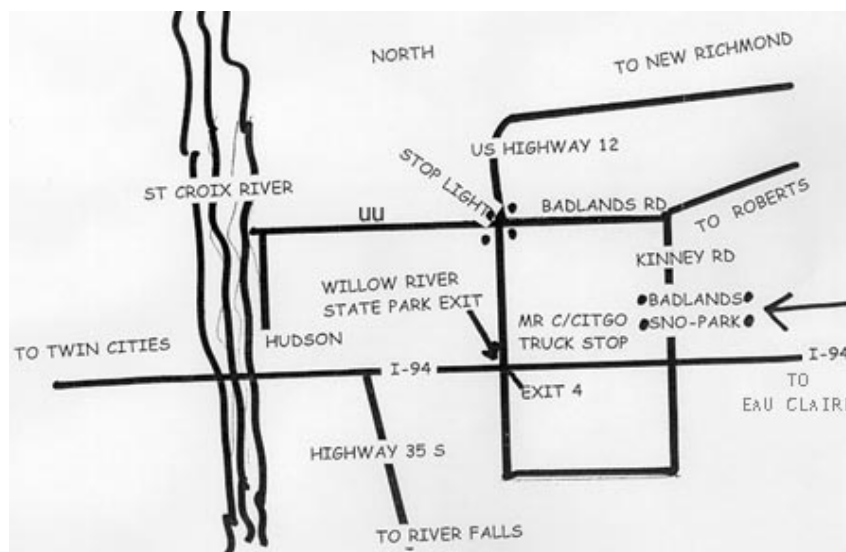

Forestry Campout w/ Crossover Activities

We will be camping at Stearns scout camp - sleeping indoors, but cooking outside. Meet at the scout building at 5:30 PM on Friday, March 26. Return will be approximately noon on Sunday. DARE training will be offered during this campout and is a requirement for second class. Because DARE is typically offered only once per year, it is especially important that boys attend if they have not already had this training. In addition, skills training for first and second year scouts will include firem'n chit, totin' chip (knife and ax) and orienteering. Lastly, we plan to participate in a maple syrup demonstration at Lake Maria State Park, work on the Forestry merit badge and do some hiking.
