U.S. Grant Pilgrimage in Galena

Troop 113 will once again be participating in a perennial favorite: the Ulysses S. Grant Pilgrimage in Galena, Illinois. Due to the travel distance, an early departure is required on Friday, April 26. Car pools have been organized around 7:00 AM departure from the Scout Building or 12:00 noon departures. **Boys leaving at noon will need a note in order to be picked up from school.** Troop and personal gear will be packed at 6:30 PM on Thursday, April 25 at the Scout Building. Please note that scouts who have not attended Tomahawk must have a parent accompany them in order to participate in this event. **Boys will need money for up to 4 restaurant meals and may want some additional spending money for arcade, mini golf, and shopping in Galena.** If everyone brings appropriate rain gear and warm clothing, this should ensure blue skies and warm temperatures.

The U.S. Grant Pilgrimage Theme for 2013 is “The Galena Vicksburg Connection.” It highlights General Grant, Civil War History, and Galena’s contributions to our Nation’s history. While attending the Grant Pilgrimage, scouts and scouters will have free admission to the Galena Historical Museum and Blacksmith shop. As usual, the troop can participate in a parade. There will be a dodge-ball competition on Saturday night.
