#### THE INCIDENT - Fall Camporee

Where: Phillippo Scout Reservation, near Cannon Falls

**Depart:** Rides are being organized. Your scout will likely be picked up directly from school on Friday ... typically a note from a parent is required.

**Cost:** \$30, with special pricing for multiple adult volunteers per family. **Permission slips are now past due.** If you have not signed up, please do so immediately!

**What:** If you don't know, you simply haven't been paying attention! Troop 113 is hosting what promises to be an epic Fall Camporee. All scouts and parents are asked to participate in every sense of the word to make this event a huge success.

**Bring:** Normal camping equipment and clothing for the weather. Pay attention to announcements for any special items that might be required. Scouts and adult leaders will be sleeping indoors.

#### Search and Rescue Merit Badge

One of the requirements for Search and Rescue Merit Badge is: Complete the training for ICS-100, Introduction to Incident Command System. Print out the certificate of completion and show it to your counselor. Discuss with your counselor how the ICS compares with Scouting's patrol method.
